



Treaty to Dissolve the State of Union between Leylandiistan and Gurvata

1. The signatories of this treaty, being the original signatories of the Treaty of Union between Leylandiistan and Gurvata, do in accordance with article 10 of the Treaty of Union between Leylandiistan and Gurvata declare that the aforementioned treaty is hereby withdrawn, and is thus null and void.
2. Hence, the state of union between Leylandiistan and Gurvata, from hereon to be referred to as “the constituent states”, is to cease upon the signature of this treaty, thus dissolving the sovereign state existing as the Confederation of Leylandiistan & Gurvata.
3. The signatories of this treaty, representing Leylandiistan and Gurvata respectively, do hereby agree that their respective constituent states shall be dissolved upon the cessation of the state of union between those constituent states.
4. All legislation enacted by the signatories of these treaty in their capacity as the collective government of the unified constituent states is hereby repealed.
5. All lands claimed by the Confederation of Leylandiistan & Gurvata are hereby returned to the Republic of Ireland.
6. All treaties signed between the Confederation of Leylandiistan & Gurvata and other sovereign states are declared null and void by this treaty.
7. The assets of the government of the Confederation of Leylandiistan & Gurvata are to be distributed as follows
 - a. All remaining funds held by the government of the Confederation of Leylandiistan & Gurvata are to be evenly distributed amongst all citizens.
 - b. All seeds held by the National Seed Bank are to be divided among the agricultural producers residing in the territory claimed by the Confederation.
